### ORDER

Attention is invited to the Order dated 16.04.2020 issued by this office, directing all offices<sup>yw</sup> and staff under the jurisdiction of Mumbai Customs Zone-III to attend the office w.e.f 20.04.2020, in compliance of the consolidated revised guidelines for containment of outbreak of COVID 19 issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India(GoI) vide Order 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 15.04.2020 and by the Commissioner(Coord), CBIC, New Delhi vide F.No.C50/30/2020 AD II, both dated 15.04.2020.

2. Subsequent thereto, an order NO. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1 dated 17.04.2020 has been issued by the Government of Maharashtra (GoM) stipulating the consolidated revised guidelines for measures to be taken for containment of spread of COVID-19 in the context of situation prevailing in Maharashtra. The Para 18(i) of latest guidelines dated 17.04.2020 issued by GoM stipulates that Customs offices will function with barest minimum strength w.e.f 20.04.2020.

3. Now, therefore, in compliance of the consolidated revised guidelines dated 17.04.2020 issued by Government of Maharashtra, the order dated 16.04.2020 and Addendum dated 17.04.2020 issued by this office are hereby withdrawn. Accordingly, the offices under the jurisdiction of Mumbai Customs Zone-III, shall function with the barest minimum staff possible as stipulated in Para 18(i) of the guidelines dated 17.04.2020 issued by the Government of Maharashtra. Respective Commissionerates shall ensure that work relating to Cargo Clearance and Preventive

operations are not hindered, and that urgent and periodic reports are sent promptly.

5. The guidelines dated 17.04.2020 of Government of Maharashtra may accordingly be complied. Further, all the staff attending the office shall ensure compliance with the social distancing and other preventive norms prescribed in above referred guidelines dated 17.04.2020.

6. In view of above, all the Heads of the Department of Customs Mumbai Zone-III Commissionerates should ensure that a roster of staff required to render essential services within each department may be drawn from 20.04.2020 to 03.05.2020, keeping in view of guidelines of Government of Maharashtra to function with barest minimum strength. The remaining staff may be directed to be available on telephone or other electronic means of communication at all times and they should attend office if called for in case of any exigencies of work.

This issues with the approval of Chief Commissioner of Customs, Mumbai Customs Zone-III.
